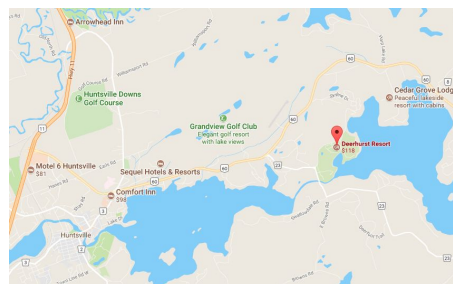
2018 IWWF World Waterski Show Tournament: Bulletin 2

Site plannings continues to be refined and the tournament has secured sponsorships for the docks, starting barges and the main stage. With the continued construction at Deerhurst the details for the spectator area and officials stand are still underway with updates due in July.

### Transportation

As outlined in the tournament agreement transportation will be coordinated for all team members who are registered and paid for as part of the team entry fee. One trip will be available for each team from Toronto International airport and the Deerhurst Resort and return trip. Teams should coordinate schedules to limit wait time for team members.

### **Team Equipment**

Team containers will be available to teams that do not have a trailer for storage throughout the week. Due to limited space teams will be limited to a trailer or a supplied container.

### **Tow Boats**

As in previous years teams will choose 3 of 4 tow boats; 1 Twin rig, 2 D-Drives and 1 V-Drive. The committee is still negotiating details on the inboard boats but have confirmed the setup for the Twin Rig.

D&S Marine is currently building a Legacy hull that will be used for the tournament and will make appearances at other tournament throughout the summer. As part of our sponsorship with Evinrude, the boat will be rigged with Twin 250 hp G2 Evinrudes.

More details to follow up on the inboards as discussions evolve.

### **Hotels & Lodging**

Lodging options at the Deerhurst Resort is limited with most of the resort booked by the tournament, teams and spectators traveling up for the weekend. For additional lodging options click, <http://worldwaterskishowtournament.com/lodging-options>.

The Deerhurst resort has put together a meal plan for any one coming to the tournament so they can easily enjoy the great buffet. This meal plan is discounted to \$58 CDN/day and includes gratuity and applicable taxes. Registration links are being finalized and will be shared with the teams by 5/15/18.

### **Events**

Events are being coordinated with the resort including bands and entertainment at the various bars nightly. The tournament will have various events that will require a pass for entry. Team entrance fee includes entry into the Wednesday night team mixer and the final banquet. Food and non alcoholic beverages will be available for all attendees. Tickets for non team members will be available for purchase through our website later this month.

### **Web Cast - Team Videos**

In an effort to highlight the teams the tournament is offering each country time on the web cast prior to their shows on Saturday and Sunday. All Videos will be due by July 31, 2018 and are subject to review and approval of all submissions.

#### **Details:**

**Saturday Video:** A 2 minute (maximum time) video about the team and country they represent.

Teams should follow the format outlined:

- Information about Country
- Information about the team
  - Overview of team
  - How many
  - From where
  - How selected
  - Why selected
- How did they train and prepare
- What did it take to get to the tournament
- What are the teams goals for the tournament

**Sunday Video:** A 3 minute (maximum time) video highlighting the team's show and acts. The following information should be followed:

- Recap who the team is
- Show
  - What is the theme
  - Why selected
  - How does it highlight the countries culture
- Acts
  - What are some of the highlights of the show
  - What are unique about the acts



#### Format:

All videos should be formatted as an mp4 or mov file and not exceed the time limit outlined in the details above.

#### Creation of video submissions:

Creation of all video submissions are the responsibility of the teams who will cover any costs associated with the production of each piece.
