Age Limit

Due to the Norwegian Sports Federations rules for children, no skier is allowed to compete in an international championship in Norway before the year they turn 13. It is not allowed to make any exceptions from this rule.

Accommodation

The official hotel is **Thon Hotel Oslo Airport**.

The hotel is located 7 km from Oslo Airport and 40 km from the site. The hotel will set up a special webpage for bookings. The link is <https://www.thonhotels.com/event/world-disabled-waterski-championships/>. Please book your hotel rooms as soon as possible and by using the above link. The hotel is located approx. 40 km (35min drive) from the site and 5 km from Oslo Gardermoen international airport.

Rooms for the period before 22. July must be booked before 15. June. Rooms for the period 22.-28. July must be booked 25. June. After these dates, we can no longer guarantee the availability or the price.

Single room rate: NOK 796 (Approx. €83/\$94)
Double room rate: NOK 996 (Approx. €103/\$118)
Triple room rate: NOK 1196 (Approx €124/\$141) (max 2 adults)

All prices are per room per night and includes a fabulous breakfast buffet.

Parking

The hotel has a large car park, but unfortunately does not offer free parking.

Per hour: NOK 13 (Approx. €1,40/\$1,50)
Per day: NOK 68 (Approx. €7,30/\$8)
Per week: NOK 225 (Approx. €24/\$27)

Transport

Airport

The main airport in Norway, and the airport we recommend, is Oslo Airport (OSL+). The official hotel is located 5 minutes from the international arrival and departure terminal. Transportation from the airport to the official hotel and from the official hotel to the airport is offered free of charge to Technical Officials, IWWF EB Members, and World Disabled Council members, and available for athletes/teams at cost.

Shuttle bus between official hotel and airport

Hotel airport shuttle service is available. The shuttle bus stop is at the lower level of the airport. The price for an adult ticket is NOK 70 (Approx. €7,50/\$8,30)

Local transport

The organizer will provide local transport between the official hotel and the site once a day. Transfers are provided free of charge for all Athletes, Team Officials, IWWF EB Members, and IWWF World Disabled Council Members.

Normally no visa is required for entry into Norway, but we strongly suggest you contact the Norwegian Embassy in your country to verify this.

Tournament Lake (Lake 1)



The tournament lake is man-made and approx. 750 meters long by 80 meters wide. In recent time the site has hosted both the IWWF E&A Open in 2011, IWWF E&A U-21 Championships in 2009 and 2016 and the IWWF E&A Disabled Championships in 2016. The site is absolutely perfect with no backwash and well protected from the prevailing winds this time of year. The average depth is 2 meters. A live web camera, displaying the site, is available 24/7 on www.vannski.info.



A second lake (Lake 2), also man made and directly adjacent to the tournament lake, will be available for training, both before, during and after the championship event. The lake has an 8 buoy slalom course.

Facilities on site

- Main Tournament Lake has club-house with offices, kitchen, toilets, showers etc.
- Second lake (available for training) also has a club house identical to the one on the main tournament lake)
- Outdoor showers on site
- Professional size Trampoline on site
- Regulation size Beach-volleyball court on site
- Powerful wireless internet service available in all corners of the site
- Paintball area and several soccer fields on site
- Available parking for 500+ cars.
- State-of-the-art and strategically positioned judges tower will ensure that the tournament will run without delays
- Lunches available on site by professional catering service. Lunches on site will be provided free of charge to all Athletes, Team Officials, Technical Officials, IWWF EB Members, and IWWF World Disabled Council members.

Ski Storage

The organization will supply storage for competitor's equipment. The organizer is not responsible for equipment that is lost or damaged.

Intention to enter

In accordance with IWWF Rule 2.05 Federations wishing to send a team to compete at the 2019 IWWF World Disabled Waterski Championships, should complete and return the "Intention to Enter" as soon as possible.

The deadline for submitting the Intention to Enter is May 26th.

For late submission of the Intention to Enter form a penalty of \$200 will be applied in accordance with IWWF Rule 2.05. To be accepted, the "Intention to Enter" must be accompanied by a deposit amounting to \$50 for each athlete mentioned on the Intention. (For instance: 3 athletes :3x\$50 = \$150).



This amount must be paid to the organizers and is non-refundable. This \$50 will be deducted from the entry fee to be paid for each athlete. The Federation may enter up to two additional athletes more than originally declared on the "Intention to Enter". If more than two additional athletes participate, then a fee of \$50 per additional athlete will be levied upon that Federation.

Entry Form/Entry Fee

In accordance with IWWF Rule 2.05 each Federation is required to submit an official Entry for the Championships. **The deadline for submitting the Entry is June 26th.** For late submission of the Entry a penalty of \$10 per day will be applied in accordance with IWWF Rule 2.05.

The Entry Fee of the 2019 IWWF World Disabled Waterski Championships fee is 380,00 USD per competitor regardless of disciplines entered by each competitor. Entry fees can be paid by bank transfer. **Deadline for payment is July 12th.**

This Entry Fee includes a levy of \$30 to assist towards the travel costs of the Official Panel. The Entry Fees of Team or Individual athletes failing to show up after having been entered by their Federation shall still be payable in full, unless a valid written excuse is received by 12 noon of the day before the start of the competition.

Familiarisation

Official familiarisation will be in the tournament lake on 23rd and 24th July. Each skier will be entitled to familiarisation in line with IWWF Disabled rule D2.08. The schedule will be published on the official website on June 27th.

Training

Training time will be offered from 9.00-15.00 in the tournament lake the week before the Championships and in Lake 2 during the Championships. [The boats used for training will be Slåstad Waterski Clubs own boats, Ski Nautique 200 6,2 l, one 2016-model and one 2018-model.](#) Training will be sold in either 15 minutes intervals or per the hour. The rates for training will be as outlined below.

TOURNAMENT LAKE:

15 minutes: NOK 500 (App. €53/\$60)

1 hour: NOK 2000 (App. €215/\$239)

LAKE 2

15 minutes: NOK 375 (App. €40/\$44)

1 hour: NOK 1500 (App. €160/\$179)

IMPORTANT: There is a 8 buoy slalom course in Lake 2 but no ramp, which means that it is preferred for trick training. The lake is shorter than Lake 1 (approx.. 450 meters long).


