The Event Venue

The NSW Barefoot Water Ski Club is located on the Georges River, Liverpool Sydney, just 23km west of the Sydney central business district including Sydney International & Domestic Airport.



Weather

The average maximum temperature at Liverpool, Sydney in April is 24C or 75F degrees. It should be noted that temperatures at this time of year often climb into the mid 30's providing a fantastic summer feel. Average rainfall is 85mm per month with 8 days per month average providing rain.

Airport

Sydney International Airport and Sydney Domestic Airport are co-located just 8km from the Sydney CBD and 23km from the site at Liverpool via the M5 Motorway. The airport is serviced by many international airlines direct or in partnership with Australia's two (2) main domestic airlines – Qantas and Virgin Australia. The airport is serviced by train, buses, taxis and rental car services.

Transportation

Sydney Airport is located just 13 minutes by train from the city. Airport Link offers a fast and convenient way to reach the city and suburbs, with trains running approximately every 10 minutes. The Airport station is located at the northern end of the terminal and accessible from the Arrivals level.

To the site at Liverpool - Trains run from Sydney Airport terminals to Holsworthy Train Station located just 5km from the site at Liverpool where taxi service is available.

An Opening and Closing Ceremony will be held at the Liverpool Catholic Club as part of the 2020 IWWF World Barefoot Water Ski Championships. The Liverpool Catholic Club and the Mercure Hotel are located at 424-458 Hoxton Park Road Liverpool.

Opening Ceremony – Saturday Night 11th April 2020

Tickets - \$75 per person - Children under 12 \$40 which includes a 3 course sit down dinner.

Closing Ceremony – Saturday Night 18th April 2020

Tickets - \$110 per person - Children under 12 \$40 which includes a 4 course sit down dinner.

The Opening Ceremony, Closing Ceremony, and Final Night Banquet are offered free of charge to Athletes, Team Officials, Technical Officials, IWWF Discipline Council Members and IWWF Executive Board Members.

Intentions to Enter and Entries

Federations intending to field a team and or independent skiers in the 2020 IWWF World Barefoot Water Ski Championships shall advise the IWWF World Barefoot Council and the LOC via committee@barefoot.org.au its intent to compete at the Championships, advising the Federations estimated entries not later than 14 February 2020. The Intent to Enter Form is contained in Appendix A of this Bulletin. Any Federation not meeting this requirement shall not be allowed to compete until they pay a fine of US\$200 to the IWWF World Barefoot Council as per Rule 2005 (A)(1).

Entry Fees

The entry fees for the 2020 IWWF World Barefoot Water Ski Championships are expressed in **US Dollars**.

Team Skiers:

- \$350

Independent Skiers:

- One event \$250 • Two Events \$300 • Three Events \$350

Dual Division Entry skiers, for a 2nd division:

- One Event \$200 • Two Events \$250 • Three Events \$300





Entries close 14 March 2020 and as per Rule 2005, each Federation shall certify to the IWWF World Barefoot Council and the Local Organising Committee;

- A maximum of 6 Open skiers and Four Junior and Senior Skiers; and
- An Independent Skier List.

Entry fees are payable in full by Federations by **21 March 2020**.

Late entries are at the discretion of the Local Organising Committee and Chief Judge and will attract a late entry fee of US\$70 which includes payment of the WBC late fee.

This Entry Fee includes a levy of US\$30.00 to assist towards the travel costs of the Official Panel. Please refer to your Letter of Agreement and Obligations.

Remitting parties are responsible for all bank charges on both ends.

Important Note – the paragraph above is standard for IWWF Waterski World Title Events in all divisions. The normal Entry Fee is increased by USD30.00 to accommodate the contribution. This is not an obligation but an option for other discipline IWWF World Titled Events.

Entry Forms - Each Federation is responsible to submit a signed entry form for each competitor before the start of the Championships. Entry forms are attached with the original signed form provided to the **LOC Secretary prior to 5pm 11 April 2020**.

Lunches on Site

There will be onsite catering from 7:30am until 3pm. Menu will include various healthy salads, sandwiches and rolls along with Hot and Cold drinks.

On Site Refreshments

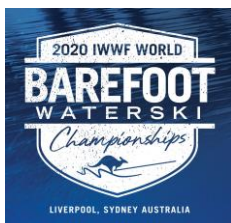
