7.1 Airport - [Hangzhou Xiaoshan International Airport \(HGH\)](#)

Hangzhou Xiaoshan International Airport is an international airport serving Hangzhou, a major city in the Yangtze River Delta region and the capital of East China's Zhejiang province. The airport is located on the southern shore of Qiantang River in Xiaoshan District and is 27 km east of downtown Hangzhou, and 30 km (40-minute drive from the Official Hotel). The Airport is also the Hub for Air China, China Eastern Airlines, Xiamen Air, Loong Air and SF Airlines.

The 2026 Hangzhou Xianghu Half Marathon will be held on 18 October 2026 from 07:30 to 12:00. Road closures around the official hotel will affect vehicle access and departures during this period. Please ensure that all registered athletes are informed and avoid scheduling travel from the hotel until the late afternoon or evening.

7.2 Visa

China now offers **VISA Free Entry into China**. Please contact the Chinese Embassy in your respective countries for specific information whether this applies to your Nationality and send your request for an invitation to <cnwaterski@126.com> by latest 31st July 2026, if one is required. [FAQ on VISA Free Entry into China](#). Passports must be valid for at least 6 months from the date of entry into China. There will be an average wait time of 20 days for an invitation.

7.3 China Arrival Card

Travelers entering mainland China may be required to complete an Arrival Card before immigration clearance. To avoid delays, participants are encouraged to complete the [Arrival Card online](#) before departure and ensure they have their passport details, travel information, and accommodation address readily available. The Arrival Card is separate from visa and entry requirements.

7.4 Airport Transfers (to Official Hotel)

Complimentary return airport transfers, from the Hangzhou Xiaoshan International Airport (HGH) to the Official Hotel, will be provided for teams/athletes staying at the Official Hotel. This will also apply to IWWF Executive Board Members, Technical Officials and Members of the IWWF World Wakesurf Council. **The contact person for transfers will be Ada Li 李皓爽, contactable at iwwf2026_xiaoshan@qq.com, and you should communicate your airport transfer requirements by 25th September 2026 at the latest by submitting your travel details using this link, after which the Organisers will presume you will manage your own airport transfers.**

The organizer will provide free transportation only from the Official Hotel to the Event Venue starting Friday, 9th October 2026 for teams & team officials, IWWF Executive Board Members, Technical Officials and Members of the IWWF World Wakesurf Council.

Please contact the hotel manager to request for taxi service. Cash, WeChat pay, and Alipay are accepted.

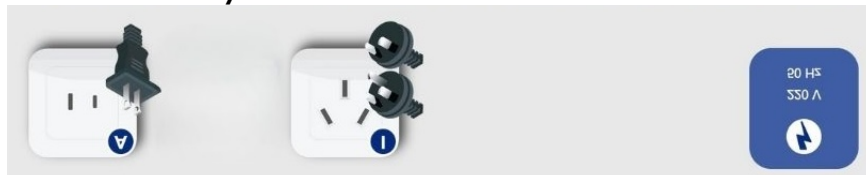
7.7 Car Rentals

8. EVENT RULES

All Federations, team managers, team captains and riders should be familiar with the [2026 IWWF World Wakesurf Rules](#).

9. CATEGORIES

9.1 Minimum Number of Riders / Country Representation

There will be a minimum of 3 different countries represented required to open a category. The categories to be opened will be determined after the end of the registration. Once a category is open, then the scores and the placement of riders in that category will contribute to team scores and to a title. A rider will only be allowed to enter one category, either the appropriate age-group category or a higher level of difficulty category than his/her own age-group category. A rider can enter both Skim and Surf disciplines. In this case, the Entry Fee must be paid twice for each discipline.

9.2 Date of Birth

A rider's age as of 31st of December of the current year will be used to determine age bracket.

10. INTENTION TO ENTER & ENTRIES

Each Federation shall submit an Intention to Enter Form no later than 13th August 2026, 60 days before the 1st scheduled competition day as per 2026 IWWF Wakesurf Rules, Rule 9b. **Any Federation not meeting this requirement will not be allowed to compete until they pay a fine of USD250.00 to the IWWF. For each participant entered on the Intention to Enter form, the Federation must pay a deposit of US\$50.00 to the Organizer – bank details can be found on page 7 of this Bulletin. This payment is non-refundable.** This payment will ensure the number of riders participating is accurate and will enable the planning of the event. If the Federation enters the number of riders as indicated in the Intention to Enter, the payment made will be deducted from the entry fee. If the Federation enters less riders than the number indicated on the Intention to Enter, the US\$50.00 paid for each of the riders not attending will be forfeited. 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10.1 Team composition and team scoring

According to Rule 9a of 2026 IWWF World Wakesurf Rules **each team can consist of maximum of 14 athletes with a total of 14 qualification rides**. The best 10 scores from all categories with a maximum of 1 rider from the same category per country will be used to calculate the overall team score.

The Organizing Committee, in consultation with the Chief Judge, reserves the right to close registration early once the maximum number of participants that can be accommodated within the scheduled event days has been reached

10.2 Fees

The Entry Fee will be US\$200.00 per rider per discipline (surf or skim). Entry fees must be paid by bank transfer to the Organizer – bank details are in paragraph 14 of this Bulletin. The deadline for payment is 28th September 2026. Please indicate your "Name of Country" and "Entry Fee 2026 IWWF Wakesurf Worlds" when making your transfer. 10.3 Registration Of Wakesurf Athletes In EMS

Each Federation shall register the athletes using the IWWF's EMS not later than fourteen (14) days before the scheduled start of the first event of the competition, with the names of the members of its team. The deadline for entry of athletes on EMS is **28th September 2026**. Any Federation not meeting this requirement will not be allowed to compete until the Federation pays a fine of US\$10.00 per rider per day after the 14 days deadline to the IWWF for each rider not officially entered. Late entries, even if paid, will only be accepted with the mutual consent of the Organizer and Chief Judge.

The registration of the rider participations in EMS has to be done by an EMS Federation Administrator as follows:

1. EMS Federation Administrator has to login to EMS
2. Go to the Competitions menu and set the Competition Code **<26IWWF10>** and the Country **"China"** in the Search Filters
3. Select the Code **<26IWWF10>** competition "2026 IWWF World Wakesurf Championships"
4. Scroll down to the Participations section and click the "New participation" button to register the Athletes
5. Enter the Name of the Athlete in the Search box and click on the loop sign to the right
6. Register the Category in Competition, the Event(s) (discipline).
7. Click on the blue "+Add" button and the participant will be registered.

Repeat Steps 5 to 7 for any additional participants

Any Federation not meeting this requirement before 28th September 2026 will not be allowed to compete until the Federation pays a **fine of USD10.00 per rider per day after this deadline to the IWWF for each rider not officially entered**. Late entries will only be accepted, even if paid, with the mutual consent of the Organizer and Chief Judge.

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11. OFFICIAL FAMILIARIZATION

Official Familiarization will be run according to rule 9c of the 2026 IWWF Wakesurf Rules. The cost of Official Familiarization at the Event Venue will be **US\$50.00 per rider for an 8-minute slot**. Each rider will only be allocated one slot. Slots have to be requested and reserved by [email](#) at the time of submission of "Intention to enter" form and paid by bank transfer to the Organiser – bank details in paragraph 14 of this Bulletin. The slots will be allocated on the "first come – first served" basis means a team will not necessarily get the training on the day requested if by the time the form is submitted that particular day is already fully booked. The Official Familiarization schedule will be subject to the number of riders and will be posted by the Organisers no later than 45 days before the beginning of the event on the official event [web site](#).

16. DOPING CONTROL

In accordance with the IWWF Anti-Doping Rules, doping controls will be conducted during the competition. By entering this competition, all athletes agree to be subject to doping control. 17. SAFE SPORT

The IWWF takes safeguarding extremely seriously and is committed to ensuring that everyone who attends the championships, whether athletes, officials or volunteers able to operate in a safe environment, free from abuse and the risk of harm. 18. INSURANCE

The IWWF Internal Regulation to the Articles (Article 11.1) state:

It is the responsibility of each Federation when entering competitors for a World Titled Event to ensure that its competitors are adequately insured for personal accident, permanent disabilities, death and medical expenses.

19. REGISTRATION & ACCREDITATION

This will be held from 9th October to 11th October 2026 from 9:00 am to 6:00 pm at the Official Hotel. Athletes will receive their accreditation, bibs (**which must be worn during Official Familiarisation and Competition**) and lunch tickets.

At the same time, passport verification will be conducted by the Chief Scorer and the Chief Judge. In accordance with Rule 9b, the Team Captain must collect the passports of all team riders and submit them to the Chief Scorer before registration closes, no later than 36 hours prior to the start of the competition.

If it is not possible to present the passports in person during registration, please ensure that copies of all passports are emailed to the Chief Scorer with a copy to the IWWF Wakesurf Council at wakesurfchair@iwwf.sport.

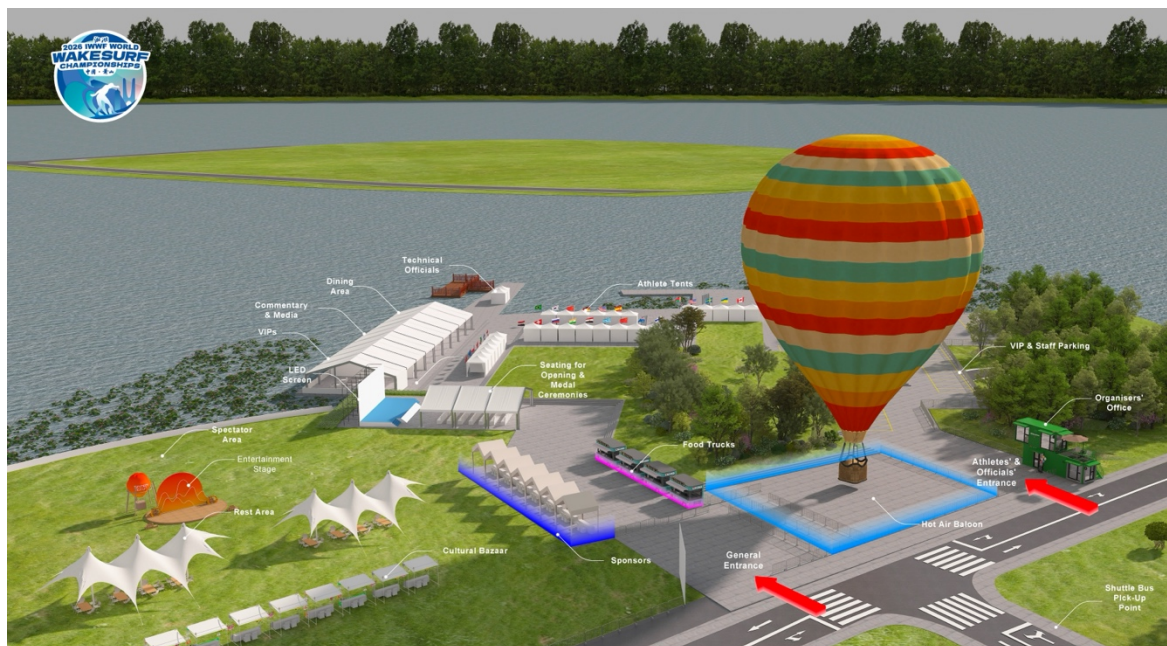

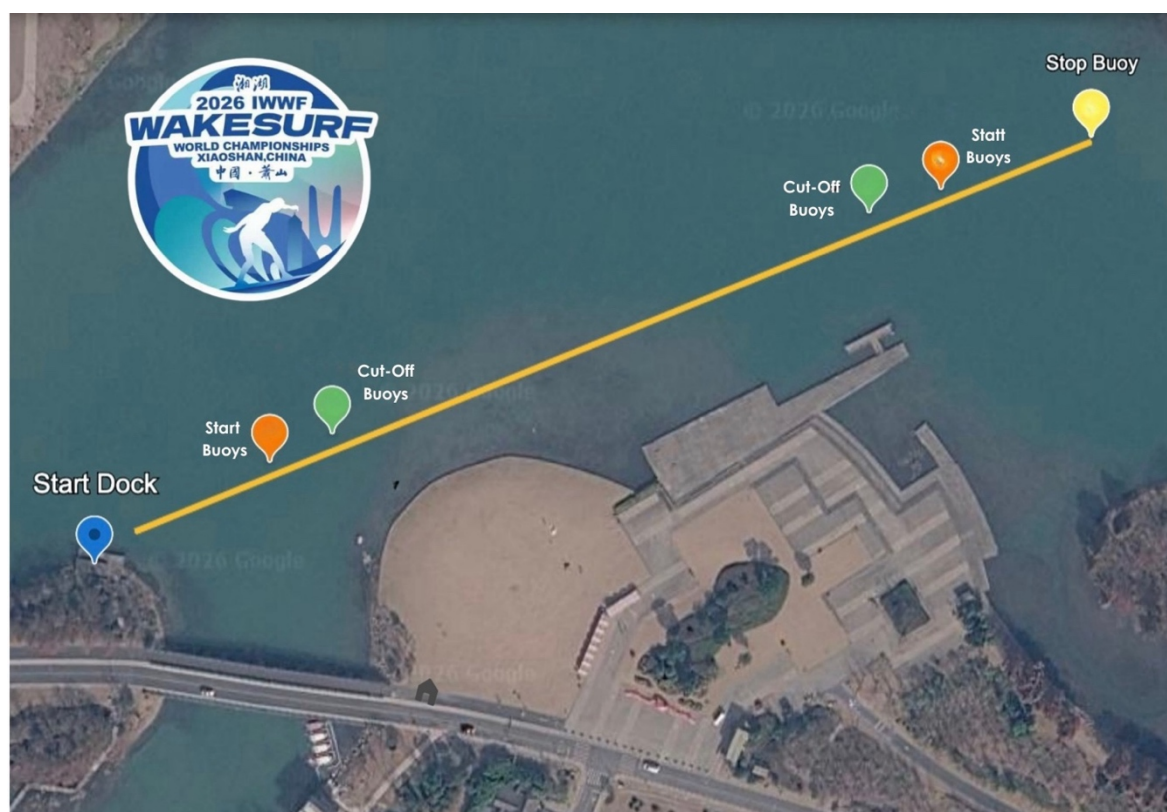
